

Working within our specialist mental health care services team, you will deliver contemporary, evidenced based direct nursing care to support the recovery and rehabilitation of mental health consumers.

Our specialist mental health nursing program opportunities include:

Transition Support Program (TSP)

The Mental Health Transition Support Program (TSP) hosted by Darling Downs Health comprises both theoretical learning and access to a range of clinical settings and areas of practice. Darling Downs Health provides a unique opportunity to have access to comprehensive range of clinical areas including acute and extended inpatient care, including medium secure rehabilitation setting and range of other specialty areas. The TSP is written at postgraduate level (AQF 8) and following successful completion of the Transition Support Program – Mental Health, you can apply for credit toward postgraduate study in mental health nursing.

Nurse Grade 2, Undergraduate Student in Nursing Mental Health Program

The student nurse (NG2) will be a student nurse who has completed the second semester of a pre-registration university nursing program or second semester of a two-year post graduate pre-registration of university program in nursing or midwifery qualification (accredited by ANMAC and approved by the NMBA). Darling Downs Health now offers a Mental Health NG2 Assistant in Nursing (AIN) program which includes an introduction to SAFEWARDS, Mental State examination, MHA2016, risk assessment and other key areas within identified scope of practice to further develop your skills in the specialty of mental health nursing.
