# Darling Downs Health Board Meeting 25 October 2022

A meeting of the Darling Downs Health Board (the Board) was held on 25 October 2022 at Baillie Henderson Hospital.

### Monday 24 October 2022

Paul Clayton, Executive Director Infrastructure and Phil Gregory, Director Projects Property and Planning held a workshop with the Board to discuss the Strategic Asset Management Plan priorities for 2022-23.

Wendy Pannach, Clinical Redesign and Innovation Manager presented to the Board providing an overview of the approach to Strategic Planning for 2022-23.

Annette Scott PSM, Health Service Chief Executive provided a comprehensive report to the Board on the operations, activity, and governance of DDH in line with identified service priorities and performance indicators.
