Emergency	2	<u>Access to</u> : ICU Level 4 at Toowoomba or retrieval to Brisbane; Surgical Level 2 access at Chinchilla and Dalby.
Maternity	1	<u>Access to</u> : Medical Imaging Level 3 at Dalby (combined public/private) and Roma; Neonatal Level 1 at Dalby; Limited or no access to ATSI worker – network to be developed.
Medical	2	<u>Access to</u> : Medical Imaging Level 2+ access at Dalby and Roma; Rehabilitation Level 2+ available at Dalby.
Medical–Children’s	2	<u>Access to</u> : Child & Youth Mental Health Level 4 - ambulatory at Dalby (Level 3 at Chinchilla), inpatient at Toowoomba; Medical Imaging Level 2 at Dalby and Roma; Neonatal Level 2 at Chinchilla and Dalby.
Medication	2	Nurse-run inpatient service only; outpatient and discharge prescriptions filled by community pharmacy. Service model for supervision and monitoring by pharmacist at Dalby developed.
Medical Imaging	1	Service supported by Tele-radiology network.
Palliative Care	1	May provide respite care and inpatient care during final days of life.
Pathology	2	I-Stat on-site supported online by Level 3 service at Dalby and Level 5 service at Toowoomba.
Rehabilitation	1	Limited or no access to ATSI worker – network to be developed.

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
