Summary of the key issues discussed, and decisions made by the Board

A meeting of the Darling Downs Health Board (the Board) was held on Tuesday 25 July 2023 at the Taroom Hospital.

Monday 24 July 2023

The Board took the opportunity to tour the Miles Hospital met with staff members thanking them for their dedication to providing excellent patient care and health services to the community.

The Board also visited the Wandoan Community Health Centre meeting with staff and members from the Wandoan Auxiliary.

The Board received a comprehensive presentation regarding activity, workforce, infrastructure and achievements at the Taroom Hospital from Karen Stumer Director of Nursing Taroom, Kerry Emery, Rural General Practice Manager and Dr Romeo Aguinaldo, locum Taroom Hospital.
