Emergency	1	<u>Access to:</u> ICU Level 4 at Toowoomba. Surgical Level 2+ at Toowoomba and Dalby.
Maternity	1	<u>Access to:</u> Medical Imaging Level 3 at Toowoomba and Dalby (combined public/ private). Neonatal Level 1+ at Toowoomba and Dalby.
Medical	2	<u>Access to:</u> Anaesthetic Level 3 at Toowoomba and Dalby. Medical Imaging Level 2+ at Toowoomba and Dalby.
Medical–Children’s	1	<u>Access to:</u> Child & Youth Mental Health Level 4 - ambulatory at Dalby and Toowoomba; inpatient at Toowoomba. Neonatal Level 1+ at Toowoomba and Dalby.
Medication	2	Nurse-run inpatient service only. Aged care residents, outpatient and discharge prescriptions filled by community pharmacy; weekend prescriptions may be filled in Emergency Dept through iPharmacy. Service model for supervision and monitoring of service by pharmacist from Dalby/Toowoomba is maturing.
Medical Imaging	1	24/7 service provided by licensed nursing and operational staff. Also provides a billable x-ray service to the local medical practices. Service supported by Tele-radiology network.
Palliative Care	1	May provide inpatient care during final days of life.
Pathology	2	I-Stat on-site supported by Level 5 service at Toowoomba and Level 3 service at Dalby.
Rehabilitation	2	Visiting allied health service for physiotherapy, speech pathology, occupational therapy and dietetics.

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
