

DARLING DOWNS HOSPITAL AND HEALTH BOARD MEETING - NOVEMBER 2025

Summary of the key issues discussed, and decisions made by the Board

A meeting of the Darling Downs Hospital and Health Board (the Board) was held on Monday 24 November at Baillie Henderson Hospital, was chaired by Dr Dennis Campbell and attended by eight (8) Board Members.

Annette Scott PSM, Health Service Chief Executive provided a comprehensive report to the Board on the operations, activity, and governance of DDHHS in line with identified service priorities and performance indicators.
