Construction of the new \$1.3 billion Toowoomba Hospital is underway at the Baillie Henderson Hospital campus.

Announced as part of the 2022/23 State Budget, the new hospital will enhance local access to services and improve patient health outcomes and experiences.

The vision for the Baillie Henderson Hospital campus will be a world-class health and knowledge precinct, centred around the new hospital.

The new hospital will provide additional overnight beds, operating theatres, Emergency Department treatment spaces, outpatient consultation rooms and diagnostic rooms, as well as expanded medical imaging, pharmacy and pathology.

The existing hospital site in Pechey Street will remain operational for select services.
